

HOW TO CARRY OUT A 'LONG' MEASURE WITH A HELPER

HELPER
at Jack end

MARKER
at Decision end



If a Marker requires help when carrying out a long measure, the 'Helper' should be at the box measure end of the string holding the point of the box measure against the face of the jack. The Marker should be at 'The Decision End' of the string, instructing the 'Helper' when to release and lock the string, whilst ensuring that the pointer is placed accurately against the closest point of the bowl being measured. Both Marker and Helper should position themselves behind the bowl and the jack (as per the diagram) both ensuring that the box measure and string are perfectly inline.
